#### Public Hearing

SB 984

Requires employer in industry with requirement to pay overtime after certain number of hours worked by employee in one day to calculate applicable overtime pay for employee on daily and weekly basis and pay greater of two amounts.

SB 294

Permits employee of contracting agency that conducts cost analysis or determines feasibility of procurement, or exclusive representative of employee's bargaining unit, to seek judicial review of cost analysis or determination.

#### Work Session

SB 41

Authorizes Employment Department to disclose information in department records to public universities, Oregon Health and Science University, and regionally accredited private nonprofit institutions of higher education to extent necessary to carry out planning, performance measurement, program analysis, socioeconomic analysis or policy analysis functions.

SB 42

Reverses amendments to statute made by Enrolled Senate Bill 1534 (2016) that were determined by United States Secretary of Labor to be out of conformity with federal law.

SB 398

Requires pay stub summary to include notice of potential availability of earned income tax credit to employee.
