Work Session

SB 1040

Ensures that private sector labor organizations and employers throughout state may enter into union security agreements to full extent allowed by federal law.

SB 201

Provides that remuneration paid to certain employee of university with governing board who lives and performs service within United States is deemed includable in employee's taxable income during period of employment with university.

SB 214

Provides that post-doctoral scholars at public universities and Oregon Health and Science University are not eligible to participate in Public Employees Retirement System or optional retirement plans offered by universities.
