Public Hearing

HB 2192

Increases term of Workers' Compensation Management-Labor Advisory Committee members from two years to three years.

HB 2335

Permits Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services, at request of party to proceeding to close workers' compensation claim, to appoint as many as three members to panel of medical arbiters in accordance with criteria director sets by rule.

HB 2336 A

Permits Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to appoint claims processing agent for selfinsured employer or self-insured employer group that defaults or cancels employer's or group's certification or that director decertifies.

HB 2337 A

Increases workers' compensation benefits for permanent total disability .

HB 2338 A

Specifies only one monthly benefit rate for children of deceased worker and uniform duration of benefits for children under 19 years of age.
