HB 2005 A
Provides definitions relating to comparable work for purposes of pay equity provisions.

Work Session

HB 2186
Provides that Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services may certify self-insurance program created by intergovernmental agreement as self-insured employer for purposes of workers' compensation insurance.

HB 2263 **
Increases fee from \$500 to \$625 for third mediation session conducted by mediator assigned by Employment Relations Board to resolve labor dispute or labor controversy. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

HB 2265 A
Allows parties to agree in writing to starting date for 150-day period after which parties involved in negotiations over terms of collective bargaining agreement may notify Employment Relations Board of need for mediator.
