I have been able to see how he was when he went into the system, it was an Assault II violent felony and now how he is as a recent parolee. The transformation is amazing and I can assure you that our budget is not so luxurious that I could just carry him. He will have to perform and earn his way, but I am hopeful that his programing at OYA has prepared him for this challenge. This would not have happened without good programs at OYA that need to be funded.

I am aware that the budget short fall is looming large in Salem, but we should favor funding of what works not just thin the soup to keep everyone alive, OYA works and deserves funding.
