I am writing to let you know how badly our schools need the passage of House Bill 2419. Having an unfunded mandate for TAG services has given schools the incentive to underidentify, and under-serve our TAG students. As a result, our TAG students spend their school years, unchallenged, frustrated, and bored-- graduating without the passion for learning they once had, and poor study habits learned by years of instruction directed to the average learner. This has led many TAG students whom I know personally to meet their first challenge, in college, with failure. These students have the potential to make some of the greatest contributions in our society-- it is imperative that we fund their education adequately so that they may take their unique sets of challenges and abilities and thrive in our public schools. I urge you to do all that you can to ensure the passage of House Bill 2419.
