I have a power boat, drift boat, canoe, raft, float tubes etc. We are a boating family, and I think we are paying way more than our fair share for fees already.

And. there wasn't enough notice for this legislation change. I only saw it because I had been involved in other OSMB actions for facility improvements. I don't think the larger boating community knows about it, or that public commenting is available.
