I'm writing to express my strong support for SB557 and HB2468

We have been treading water for far too long on climate change, waiting for action elsewhere, hoping that we have a little longer until the impacts are felt here at home in Oregon. The time to act has come; we can no longer wait for movement at the federal level and the impacts are here. Moreover, Oregon is uniquely situated to share the lead with our west-coast partners who have already placed a cap and price on climate pollution. The systems are in place, ready for us to join and reap the economic and public health benefits.

I'm ready to shift from explaining to my six-year old daughter how the smoke-choked summer days come from nearby wildfires that burn more broadly thanks to climate change, to telling her about the good choices that Oregon legislators are making to protect her generation.
