Existing legislation
allows those veterans who have
received a disability due to
military service to receive an
exemption on property taxes for
their home

SB 694 brings this legislation to the modern era.

40% disabled (\$15000 exempt) \$60000

60% disabled (\$18000 exempt) \$65000

100% disabled (\$18000 exempt) \$150000*

*Counties can set criteria for receipt of largest exemption

Surviving spouses can also receive exemption with conditions

Example of Exemption

\$15000 exemption is allowed to grow by 3% per year
If you fought in the Persian Gulf war, returned home in
1994 with 40% disability

In 2017, your exemption has grown to \$29604.00

That is an increase of \$14604.00 or \$ 635/yr*

* 3% compounded over 23 years

We owe our veterans more

For disabled veterans, who have honorably served
our country
