To the Chairs and Committee members,

I am opposed to changes in our voter registration system which would allow registration as little as one day prior to an election. I can seriously imagine that someone could vote in another state by mail-in ballot, and then provide "evidence" just a few days before an Oregon election that they actually live here, even after voting elsewhere. I think this places our elections at risk to and could negate the votes of people who actually do live here full time.

Please do not advance SJR2. I am a US citizen and permanently live in Multnomah County.
