Statewide Longitudinal Data System

- ✓ <u>Defined as</u>: a data system that collects and maintains detailed, high quality data over time that is linked across the education continuum
- ✓ <u>Status:</u> The Chief Education Office has completed the initial transfer of data from the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) and Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC).
- ✓ <u>Completion:</u> The project plan provides for completion of the SLDS by December 2017
- ✓ <u>Future Inclusions:</u> The inclusion of data from the ODE Early Learning
 Division, Oregon Employment Department, and the Teachers Standards and
 Practices Commission is in the planning stages
- ✓ <u>Managing Risk:</u> The Chief Education Office adhered to high standards and followed requisite processes to ensure effective risk management and data security.




State Longitudinal Data System: Value and Benefit


- ✓ Policy makers: evaluate programs, policies and resource allocation decisions at state and local level to improve student outcomes
- ✓ Institutions: evaluate individual and collective efficacy toward common goals
- ✓ Researchers: utilize a pre-school to career real-time data source to allow for deeper understandings of effective programs and practices
- ✓ Educators: evaluate curriculum and classroom practices based on longer-term student outcomes
- ✓ **Students and Families:** identify college and career goals and see the best pathways to success
