WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Allows ports to enter into intergovernmental agreements allowed by Oregon Revised Statute Chapter 190.

BACKGROUND:

Current Oregon law restricts the types of intergovernmental agreements ports may enter into to those that improve or maintain bays, harbors, channels, banks, and shores. Chapter 190 of the Oregon Revised Statutes allows units of local government to enter into intergovernmental agreements for a broader number of reasons and purposes.

House Bill 2089 would allow ports to enter into any intergovernmental agreement currently allowed under ORS Chapter 190.
