

**SB 209 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY**

**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Allows for-profit entities that provide educational services for virtual charter schools to employ school staff if the employee is an administrator with no teaching responsibilities and the executive officer of the sponsor and the charter school governing body approve employment by the for-profit entity. Approval may be granted for all employees of the for-profit entity who are administrators with no teaching responsibilities, based on the job categories of certain employees, or on a case-by-case basis.

House Bill 3093 (2013) sunset the prohibition on for-profit entities employing charter school staff on July 1, 2018. Senate Bill 209 removes the sunset.
