Oregon should welcome and promote honest and transparent business owners and discourage and deny anonymous corporations. Currently, our state is promoting shell company abuse due to the inaction and steps to mitigate the problem. A shell company provides anonymity to its owner (or owners), allowing otherwise recognizable public figures, corporations and criminals to operate under the cloak of secrecy. My business, on the other hand, is following the rules and abiding the laws and not using shell companies to evade taxes and participate in criminal activities.
