Founded in 1924, the AMA is the premier advocate of the motorcycling community. We represent the interests of millions of on- and off-highway motorcyclists. Our mission is to promote the motorcycling lifestyle and protect the future of motorcycling.

One recommendation in the National Agenda for Motorcycle Safety (US DOT HS 809156, November 2000) is "Appropriate sanctions should be applied to those found guilty of contributing to motorcycle crashes."

The AMA thanks you for introducing HB 2598, which expands the offense of vehicular assault to include contact with a motorcycle, motorcycle operator or motorcycle passenger. All too often, existing law does not take into account the difference between property damage and actual physical harm suffered by victims of crashes caused by reckless roadway users. As you are well aware, vulnerable roadway users, such as motorcyclists, bicyclists, and pedestrians, are at a distinct disadvantage in collisions with larger motorized vehicles.
