2015-2016 Graduation Data Cohort 12-13

This data is in regards to full academic year cohort 12th graders
Full academic year means enrolled by October 1 through the end of the year

- ORCA's 4-year graduation rate has increased over 38% in the 7 years of graduating classes
 - 15-16 4-year cohort graduation rate is **61.74%**
- **91%** of full academic year cohort 12th graders graduated (started high school in 12-13)
- **25%** of graduates started at ORCA in 9th grade (12-13)
 - **75%** of graduates were enrolled elsewhere at some point during their high school career
- **13%** of graduates enrolled after the first day of school in 15-16
- **75%** of graduates started the 15-16 school year on track (with 18+ credits)
- **25%** of graduates were not "on track" to graduate at the beginning of the 15-16 school year and recovered enough credits to graduate on time
 - **15%** of these students that graduated were 0.1-2 credits deficient
 - **9%** of these students that graduated were 2.1-4 credits deficient
 - **1%** of these students that graduated were 4+ credits deficient
- **45** additional students graduated ahead of their cohort in 15-16
- Of those that did not graduate, **95%** entered ORCA high credit deficient
 - **46%** of non-graduates were more than 4 credits deficient upon enrollment
- Of those that did not graduate, **22%** started after the first day of school in 15-16
