Language acquisition in children with hearing loss starts with early and appropriate access to sound through hearing aids, cochlear implants and/or FM systems. Hearing technology is a financial burden on many families, especially when insurance does not cover hearing aids or only covers a portion. Amplification will benefit all children with all degrees and configurations of hearing loss. We know that listening technology is vital in preventing developmental delays in children.
