Testimony, SB 280, Funding for Teaching Inclusive Oregon History

The mandate to prepare and teach our students an up-to-date, inclusive history of Oregon is already engraved in ORS 329.492. But because funding for education in Oregon has been so outrageously shortchanged for so long, the funds needed for this effort have not been provided.
