

I strongly support HB 2927. If about another dozen states commit their electors to vote for the candidate who wins the popular vote nationwide, the country will be guaranteed a National Popular Vote without the cumbersome process of getting a constitutional amendment through a divided Congress before obtaining the approval of the states (or trying for the risky process of calling a Constitutional convention). The Constitution gives the power of choosing Electors to the states—it never mentioned that a state needed to direct its Electors to vote for the winner of the popular vote in that state!
