Research indicates that well-developed preschool programs could have bridged the gap I identified.

As the daughter of migrant workers, I knew my kids were disadvantaged but I did not know how. I as a mother, have identified that this disadvantage came from lack of resources available to me and equally important, my children.

Please prioritize funding early childcare and preschools. The best investment of our state dollars is in our children. We must expand opportunities for education not repeal them. Please prioritize sustaining the momentum that is already in place for our most vulnerable population, our preschoolers.
