The Multnomah County Courthouse

- Built between 1909 and 1914
- Seismically deficient
- Functionally obsolete
- Serious safety concerns for the public, defendants, Sheriff and Judges



Seismic Risk to Courthouse

- Courthouse not built to 21st century seismic standards
- Constructed from hollow core bricks
- Courthouse likely to collapse in a major earthquake and could have major damage in a minor earthquake

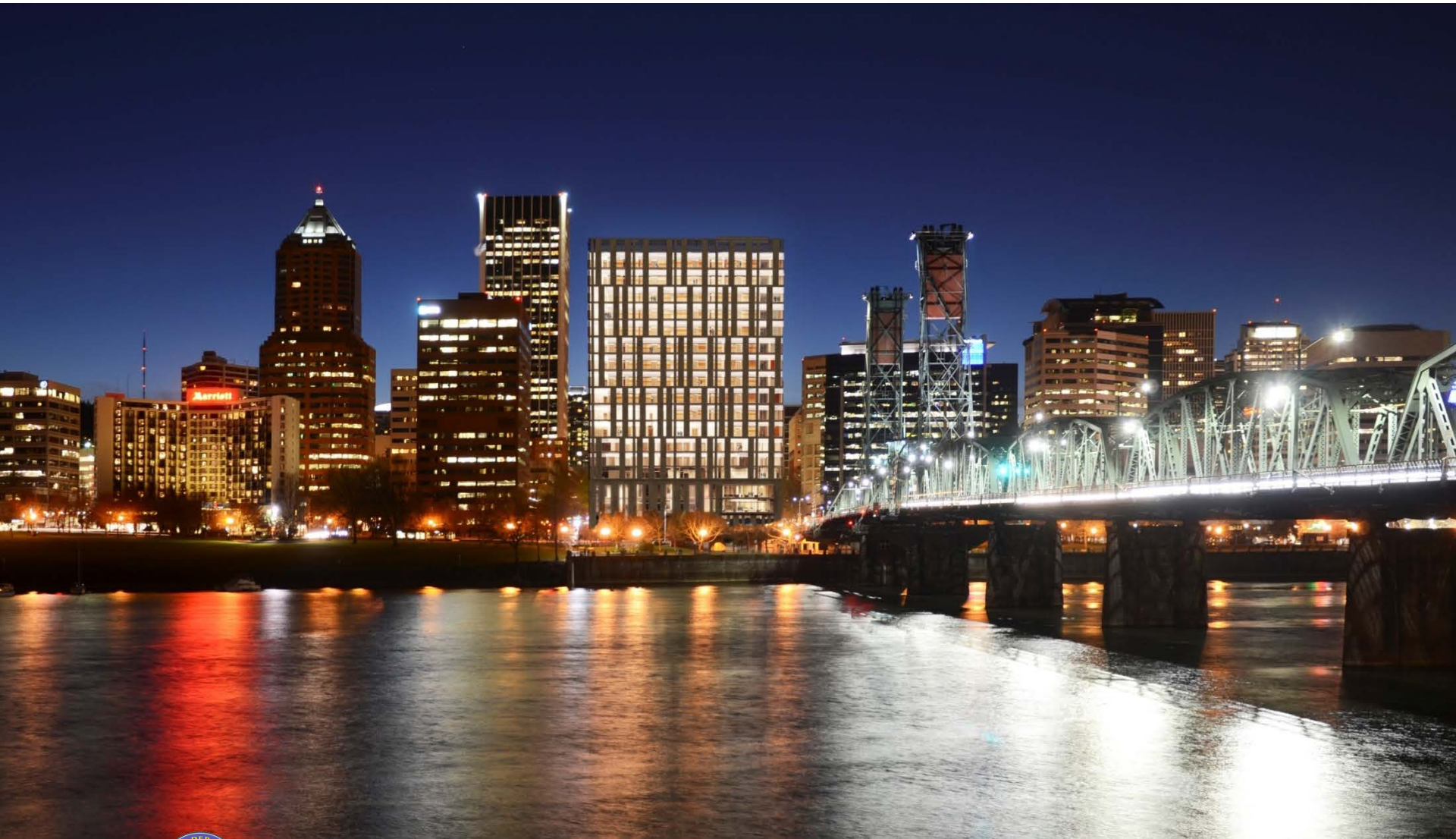

Courthouse Design elements

- 17 stories, 462,000 square feet
- Includes sally-port, separate pathways for defendants
- Public Defense Services will be co-located
- Project revised to include high-volume courtrooms, DA office



Budget and Financing

- Project Budget \$300M
- State Budget for Construction \$125M
- State construction contribution remains the same
 - State commitment to date \$32.4M
 - 2017-19 Request
 - \$92.6M for Construction
- County Portion of Budget \$175M
 - County commitment to date \$61.3M
