### **HB 2669 - Toxics Reporting and Community Right to Know Bill**

The State Fire Marshall's office has been very helpful in supplying lists of toxic chemicals that industries in Washington County are required to submit to them. However the hazardous and extremely hazardous chemicals are listed in tons, not in pounds. The requirement in HB 2669 that all industries who use 50 pounds or more of hazardous chemicals have to report to the local Fire Marshal in "Materials Balancing" where their toxic chemicals go in the environment - to air, water and land and waste streams - is very important.
