My name is Cindy Young a member of EPAC. I live in Portland a half mile away from Bullseye glass. It's been just over a year since we were hear at the capitol addressing issues concerning heavy metals in our air soil and water from a glass manufacturer.

I'm hear again to ask you to please support the house bill 2669 right to know.

After finding out my family and I had been exposed to high levels of heavy metals for 30yrs and testing above safe benchmarks for cadmium this bill is imparative.

I've had 3 pre-cancerous tumors taken out with no family history of breast cancer. After speaking with endocrinologists and other physicians they see a correlation between heavy metals and breast cancer as well as other health issues. Having the information of what toxics you've been exposed to or are being exposed to is very important. We're hoping that all toxics including diesel will be filtered and monitored from here on out. However with the status of the EPA and lack of concern from our current administration that may not be the case. So I ask you to please support this bill and the funding of DEQ to keep Oregonians safe.
