I am asking you to support HB 2669 because we need a comprehensive and accurate toxics reporting system. It has been made obvious to me through my work for the past many years to limit and monitor the chemical emissions from the Hillsboro OR plants of Intel that the methods of reporting are completely inadequate! Monitors are not numerous enough nor are they checked unannounced so the company can use averages that do not account for toxic spikes that poison the community. While driving by the Intel plant on the way to the market I pulled my car new car off the road thinking it was exhausting chemicals. It was NOT, it was the stench of toxic chemical plastic smelling fumes of the air. I have smelled this for years. I have reported this to DEQ more than once.
