WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Increases surcharge collected for the issuance of Crater Lake National Park registration plates from \$10 to \$15.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued

BACKGROUND:

Senate Bill 821 (2001) established the Crater Lake National Park registration plates to commemorate the centennial of the establishment of the park. All proceeds net of administrative costs were to be transferred to the National Park Foundation to fund projects at the park. Senate Bill 568 (2007) directed the Department of Transportation to transfer the net fees to the Oregon Community Foundation for the purposes of funding projects at the park. The proponents of that measure believed that transferring the funds to the Oregon Community Foundation would result in higher rates of investment earning and therefore greater revenue to the park.
