Directs State Parks and Recreation Department to allow disabled veterans to reserve use of state parks one month prior to the general public.

BACKGROUND:

Oregon offers a wide range of outdoor recreational opportunities, which attracts veterans and other residents. Oregon's Department of Fish and Wildlife currently offers a permanent combined hunting and fishing license for qualifying disabled veterans, and the State Parks and Recreation Department provides free day use and camping at RV and tent sites year-round for service-connected disabled veterans and U.S. Armed Forces active duty personnel on leave on Memorial Day, Independence Day and Veterans Day.

Senate Bill 380 requires the State Parks and Recreation Department to allow disabled veterans to reserve use of state parks one month prior to the general public.
