I support 2705 and 2706. Developing wise policy without metrics is impossible. If OWRD and the Legislature don't know how much water is diverted to human use, the legislature cannot write policy and OWRD cannot manage the resource.

Requiring water rights users to pay \$100 per year is a drop in the bucket. The water is state owned. The holder of the water rights should pay a user fee for administering the water rights program.
