WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Prohibits peace officer from using deceit, trickery, artifice or any other misleading interrogation technique during interview of youth in connection with act that, if committed by adult, would constitute a crime.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

-1 Replaces measure. Prohibits peace officer from using deceit, trickery or artifice, or promising leniency or any other benefit, during interview of a minor in connection with investigation of a crime or act that, if committed by adult, would constitute a crime. Inculpatory statements derived from violation of this provision is involuntarily made.

BACKGROUND:

House Bill 3244 prohibits law enforcement from using deceit, trickery, artifice or any other misleading interrogation technique during an interview of a youth in connection with an act that, if committed by an adult, would constitute a crime.
