Analysis:

HB 2134-3 increases the amount of funds collected by electric companies for low-income bill payment assistance from \$15 million to \$20 million per year. Funds are collected by the Housing and Community Services Department and distributed through the state's Community Action Agency network. The bill takes effect January 2, 2018, resulting in a \$5 million expenditure and revenue impact to the Housing and Community Services Department for the 2017-19 biennium, and a \$10 million expenditure and revenue impact for the 2019-21 biennium.
