

HB 2497 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Requires Oregon Fish and Wildlife Commission to establish and prescribe fees for multiyear resident and nonresident hunting licenses. Limits amount issuing agent may charge to \$5 fee and limits the fee that certain other license agents may retain of \$5 fee to \$2.50.

REVENUE: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued.

FISCAL: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

In 2013, House Bill 2252 allowed the Oregon Fish and Wildlife Commission (Commission) to establish multiyear hunting licenses. However, the Commission does not currently offer multiyear hunting licenses.

House Bill 2497 would require the Commission to establish multiyear hunting licenses.
