Dear Chair Keny-Guyer and members of the Human Services and Housing Committee:

I write on behalf of Oregon Opportunity Network (Oregon ON) to urge your support for HB 3192, which will invest \$5 million in flexible down payment assistance to provide a hand-up for at least 250 first-time home-buying families of moderate means.

You will be hearing from our nonprofit members around the state, who work with first-time homebuyer families to prepare them for the long-term stability and prosperity that comes with homeownership. Not only does homeownership set up children and families for success in school and employment, it anchors families in their communities and enables them to build wealth and assets for the future. Having folks move up into homeownership also frees up desperately needed units in rental housing.

One-time down payment assistance can transform a household on the margins into a family with the capacity to thrive as homeowners.

We are very excited to bring this bill forward as part of a comprehensive agenda to increase affordable homeownership in Oregon, along with home repairs (HB 2961), a revolving loan fund for home development (HB 2570), extending LIFT bond capacity to include affordable single-family homes (HB 3175), and funding for foreclosure assistance.

We urge your support of HB 3192, and we thank you as always, for your service to Oregon.
