**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Allows a smoke shop certified by the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to allow on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

**BACKGROUND:**

All smoke shops must be certified by the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) and abide by specific requirements before permitting smoking on the premises. Under current Oregon law, a certified smoke shop cannot sell, offer, or allow on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages.

House Bill 2736 would lift that prohibition and allow the consumption of alcoholic beverages in OHA certified smoke shops.
