Subject: HB 2931 – Behavior Analysis Interventionist requirements for certification

Chair Greenlick and members of the committee; I am Sylvie Donaldson, director of the Health Licensing Office.

While the Health Licensing Office is neutral on all bills, I am here to talk about the impact of House Bill 2931.

The bill adds “*a degree from a post-secondary institution*” to the existing requirement of a high school diploma or a General Educational Development certificate for registration as a behavior analysis interventionist.

The bill’s language is simple and straightforward, and it fits with how the Health Licensing Office operates.
