option to waive the fundamentals of engineering examination and practical engineer's requirements for an applicant for Oregon State license registration if the applicant has, for at least eight years prior to the date of the application and if the individual has held a registration or license to practice professional engineering in another state, a territory or possession of the United States, the District of Columbia or a foreign country.

> The PNWER Workforce Development Working group has been actively engaged in encouraging each PNWER Jurisdiction to adopt similar legislation that would allow reciprocal licensing acknowledgement of professional engineers that meet the necessary requirements. The states and provinces that already have this legislation provide their professional engineers increased mobility and access to markets.
