

**Subject:** Support of SB 869

Dear Senators/Senate Committee on Health,

I am a resident in Umatilla County and in support of **informed** consent. I believe all people, adults and children alike, need to have the proper education about vaccines before administered. Most people are coming for their vaccinations either for the fact they are required or they see benefit. Our communities in Oregon and across society are lacking knowledge of the risks involved, most do not know there is such thing. By having information of risk or adverse reactions at the hands of the patient, we are giving them the chance to be informed before consent of a vaccine. I find the following to be vital by the definition of *informed* consent:

- Provide notice of the risks of each vaccination
- Provide a copy of the vaccine package insert for that vaccine
- If person is receiving a vaccination, provide notice of how to file a petition for a claim pursuant to the National Vaccine Injury Compensation Program established by the United States Department of Health and Human Services, including the contact information necessary to fill a claim.
