## Support for Stronger Informed Consent Vaccination Policies--SB869; SB580

Vaccinations have been described by the United States Supreme Court as "Unavoidably Dangerous". As a citizen scientist and parent, I cannot in prove in absolute terms, that my son did not fair well from his childhood vaccinations. However, I can make a compelling case.
