WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Decreases vehicle registration fee for truck tractor used exclusively to tow travel trailer for personal use.

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Under current law, a truck tractor is subject to registration fees based on the registration weight of the vehicle. These registration fees were intended for vehicles designed for transporting property for hire. A truck tractor is a short truck with a driver's cab, possibly a sleeper unit, but no body, designed for hauling a trailer or semi-trailer.
