Draft amendments to SB 984

The amendment to ORS 652.020 should read:
(b) If an employee works more than 10 hours in one day as described in paragraph (a) of this subsection, and also works more than 40 hours in one week as referenced in ORS 653.261(1), the employer shall calculate overtime on a daily and weekly basis and pay the greater amount of the two. The employer satisfies both overtime requirements by doing so.

The amendment to ORS 653.265 should use parallel language to the above: (2) If an employee works more than 10 hours in one day as described in subsection (1), and also works more than 40 hours in one week as referenced in ORS 653.261(1), the employer shall calculate overtime on a daily and weekly basis and pay the greater amount of the two. The employer satisfies both overtime requirements by doing so.
