## **BACKGROUND:**

In 2015 the Oregon Legislature enacted House Bill 2892 to require display of the National League of Families' POW/MIA flag that symbolizes the nation's concern and commitment to resolving, as far as possible, the fates of Americans still held prisoner or who remain unaccounted for in Southeast Asia. Senate Bill 992 takes another step, designating the third Friday of each September, "Oregon POW/MIA Recognition Day."
