I was a participant in the Family Preservation Project's resource room while incarcerated at Coffee Creek. I served 16 1/2 years and was separated from my daughter La'Shuanta when she was 2 yrs old. Out of all the programs and staff members I have worked with to develop, heat and maintain a relationship with my daughter through Only F.P.P was able and willing to help. They provided weekly phone calls, weekly letter & card mailings and were there to support and navigate on whatever level was needed to re-connect and maintain our relationship. You see me & my daughter had no contact for 8 1/2 years. But F.P.P changed that.

The reason myself and La'Shuanta are not there to share this ourselves is because she is in school completing her senior year so she can begin her marine training and I am currently

on site on my job / career as an apprentice
Ironworker.

Please know that you supporting
these bills to place money into F.P.P
is lowering recitivism rates and stopping
a cycle. I see it with my daughter.
