**Measure Description:**

Requires that public bodies develop and implement policies for securely removing personal information from digital data storage devices and other electronic data storage devices owned by public body, leased by public body or otherwise under control of public body before selling, donating, recycling or otherwise disposing of device.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Cities, Counties, Statewide

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on General Government and Accountability to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. This measure requires that public bodies establish policies for the secure removal of personal data from digital and other electronic devices. The measure will affect all state agencies, local governments, and other public entities. The measure is anticipated to have a fiscal impact but the amount of the impact is still being determined. A more complete fiscal analysis on the bill will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
