




Portland Metro Employment

Earnings Full Time Workers 50 Largest US Cities



In 2006, Portland was ranked 19th for wages.


Mean Earnings by City Full Time Workers




Average Income Full Time Workers - 2014





College Degree Age 35 - 44




East County has the Highest Concentration of Poverty in Oregon



Inequity by Race


Full Time Workers Earning Less than \$30,000

Aligning Workforce Planning

GOAL:

Increase number of citizens in East Multnomah County with higher wage jobs.

STRATEGY:

By 2017-18, train **1000 adults** in three industry sectors: **1**) Advanced Electronics, **2**) Advanced Manufacturing Metal & Machinery, and **3**) Distribution.

Aligning Workforce Planning

TACTIC

- Train 75% local; 25% outside
- Use the strength of the **existing workforce** in east Multnomah County
- Recruit 70% "aspirational jobs"; and 30% "stepping stone jobs"
- Target industry sectors with a wide spectrum of jobs
- Address growing diversity

BUDGET GOAL:

\$5,000,000 (\$5000 per adult)
