





# Governor's priorities


- Child Advocacy: Protect children in foster care and other vulnerable people


# Agency's emerging issues

# Reductions

- o Reduced General Fund by \$10.7 million
- Governor's Budget reduces the Attorney's General proposed rate from \$198 to \$185 per hour
- o Statewide adjustments
  - Reductions to the DAS Price List and State Government Service Charges
