Measure Description:

Provides that portion of Interstate 5 shall be known as Atomic Veterans Memorial Highway.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT)

Analysis:

HB 3207 designates the portion of Interstate 5 between Albany and Salem as the Atomic Veterans Memorial Highway, and directs the Oregon Department of Transportation to place and maintain suitable markers along that section of Interstate 5. The bill is anticipated to have a minimal impact on ODOT.

The Legislative Fiscal Office notes that the bill prevents ODOT from using public funds for the installation and maintenance of the markers, and has not identified an alternate revenue source, which suggests that ODOT may need to dedicate resources to apply for grants or perform private fundraising activities.
