

HB 2311 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY

House Committee On Higher Education and Workforce Development

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Revises 40-40-20 higher education goals to relate to adult Oregonians completing education, rather than to all adult Oregonians. Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission, in coordination with State Workforce Investment Board, to establish educational attainment goals for adult Oregonians not currently enrolled in kindergarten through grade 12 school, an institution of higher education or another post-secondary training program by rule.

REVENUE: No revenue impact.

FISCAL: Has minimal fiscal impact.

BACKGROUND:

Oregon's state educational goals, known as "40-40-20," were adopted in 2011. By 2025, the state aims for 40 percent of Oregonians to have obtained a bachelor's degree or higher, 40 percent to have an associate's degree or certificate in a skilled occupation, and the remaining 20 percent to have a high school diploma or equivalent credential.
