Measure Description: Allows children over the compulsory school age to not attend public full-time schools for only one year under specified circumstances. Takes effect on July 1, 2017.

Revenue Impact (in \$Millions): -3 amendments to HB 3029 do not affect the formula revenue available for distribution to school districts and education service districts. If the specified exception reduces enrollment at public schools, the formula revenue per weighted Average Daily Membership (ADMw) will increase. It is not known how many children will take advantage of this exception. Consequently, the impact on formula revenue per ADMw is not known.
