Measure Description: Requires the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) to provide education of students for the first 30 calendar days after an eligible day treatment program or an eligible residential treatment program begins operations or expands operations to a different school district. Directs ODE to pay to a school district, certain costs incurred by the district in relation to an eligible day treatment program or an eligible residential treatment program that begins operations, expands operations or closes or ceases operations in the district.

Revenue Impact (in \$Millions): This bill has a subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. A detailed analysis will be done when the bill reaches the committee.
