# **Trends Impacting DHS Services**

- Fast-growing population of older adults
- Increasing number of people with disabilities
- Growing racial, ethnic diversity
- Uneven pace of economic recovery, especially in rural parts of the state; jobs returning, but with lower skills, wages & hours
- Increasing cost of housing
- Uncertainties re: federal programs and funding

# The Safety Net: Oregonians often receive more than one service

- Medicaid (Oregon Health Plan)
- SNAP (food assistance)
- Services for older adults and people with physical disabilities
- Temporary Assistance to Needy Families
- Services for people with intellectual/developmental disabilities
- Employment Related Day Care
- Vocational Rehabilitation
- Support services for families involved with child welfare
  - 35% receive two services
  - 20% receive three services
  - 6.5% receive four services
  - 1.5% receive five or more

Working to keep children safely at home whenever possible, providing safe and appropriate placements for children who cannot remain at home



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#### DHS Budget Decisions Our Guiding Principles

- ✓ Maintain safety and stability for clients we serve
- ✓ Preserve high-quality programs that serve clients
- Preserve the infrastructure that supports these services
- ✓ Support employment, choice and independence
- ✓ Reduce cross-program impact and cost shifting
- Avoid moving people into higher cost settings or services
- ✓ Reduce the loss of federal matching funds
- Choose between repeated reductions and ending program/service
