

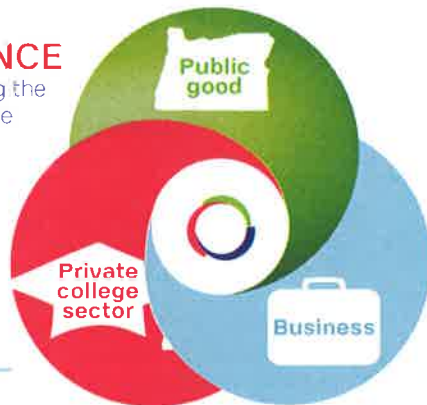

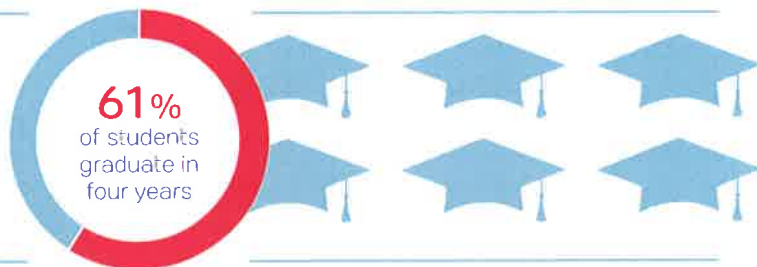

E3: EARN, EDUCATE, EMPOWER

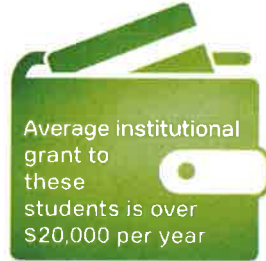

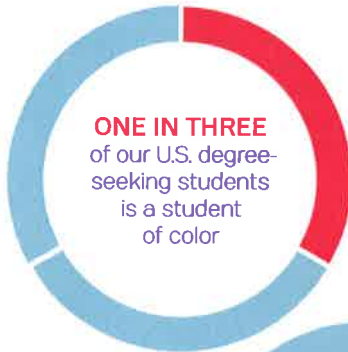
