**Subject**: HB 3025 Relating to Energy Efficiency Standards for Battery Charger Systems

On behalf of the Consumer Technology Association™ (CTA), we appreciate the opportunity testify in support of HB 3025.

While we would prefer national rather than state-level energy efficiency requirements, the proposed HB 3025 corrects an unintentional inclusion of embedded small battery chargers under the definition and scope of Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE) energy efficiency standards.

Passage of HB 3025 will head off an unnecessary disruption in the supply chain of numerous information technology products that include rechargeable battery subsystems as detailed in testimony from ITI. CTA encourages the committee to approve HB 3025.
